

THE ROMANS ROAD TO SALVATION

The "Romans Road", taken from the book of Romans, gives us complete assurance of the Good News that we are saved through faith in Jesus Christ. The following scriptures shows the need, the reasons and the how to be saved, as well as the assurance of salvation.

1. NONE is Righteous

Romans 3:10 "As it is written: there is none righteous, no, not one ... " (Isaiah 53:6; Ecclesiastes 7:20) Romans 3:23 " ... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God ... "

Romans 5:12 "Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned ... " (Genesis 1:31; 2:17; 3:16; 3:17)

2. The PENALTIES of sin

Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death ... "

3. THE WAY out of sin

Romans 5:8 "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (John 3:16; 14:6)

4. The RESULT is ASSURANCE of salvation

Romans 8:1 "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus ... "

Romans 6:23 " ... but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Romans 8:38-39 "For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor

powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall

be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord." (1 John 5:11-12; Acts

2:38-39; Revelation 3:20; John 1:12)

PRAYER

separated me from You and that I actually deserve eternal punishment and death.

Thank You for sending Jesus to die in my place. I believe that Jesus was raised from the dead
